## TOWN OF BONE LAKE BOARD MINUTES

## SEPTEMBER 9, 2025

Chairman Andy Brown called the September meeting of the Town of Bone Lake to order at 7:12 pm at the Bone Lake Lutheran Church

Roll call was taken. Present were Chairman Andy Brown, Supervisor Nate Bell and Supervisor Nancy Beduhn. Also, present were the clerk, treasurer, 2 town residents.

The minutes of the August 14th meeting were read by Clerk Ellen Gnan. Supervisor Nancy Beduhn moved to approve the minutes as read with a second by Supervisor Nate Bell.

Treasurer Rhonda Bazey gave the treasurers report showing \$78,173.96, in checking and \$59,542.83 in savings. Total funds available \$137,716.79. Mrs. Bazey informed the board that she had the paperwork for opening the new accounts at Sterling Bank for the clerk and chairman's signatures. Mr. Bell moved to approve the treasurers report with a second by Mrs. Beduhn.

Public Comments: Gerry Albright reported the brush pile at the park had been moved. Chairman Brown reported the pile would be burned soon. Doug Route reported some trees that need trimming at the Ward Lake Landing and that boaters ignored the cones and caution tape placed after the repairs were done.

Mr. Brown explained the reason for the animal control ordinance review. After some discussion, some questions arose that will be researched and the item was tabled until the October 14<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Doug Route reported that the \$35 recycling fee that was added to everyone's tax bill in 2025 will not go away but be added into the regular tax bill in future years. The supervisors are working to correct that situation. Mr. Route also reported that the Gandy Dancer Bridge over 270<sup>th</sup> has been deemed unsafe and will be removed and the approach to 270<sup>th</sup> slopped down to the road on each side.

Mrs. Beduhn moved to pay the invoices with a second by Mr. Bell. Checks numbering 11779 thru 11785 were issued totaling \$59,320.51.

Mr. Bell reported that he had spoken with Danny from Nick's Trucking who inquired if the Town wanted the ditches mowed a second time. The board decided that was not necessary. The gravel crushing is underway at the pit. The work being done by Pope Gravel.

No further business appearing, Mr. Bell moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Mrs. Beduhn The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 pm.
