

ORDINANCE 1-2026

STATE OF WISCONSIN

TOWN OF BONE LAKE—POLK COUNTY

The Town Board of the Town of Bone Lake, Polk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.07(8), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, once adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the installation of stop signs on town highways in the town as follows:


- A. Stop signs shall be placed on 250th Avenue in the town at each entrance of that road onto 95th Street, making that intersection a 4-way stop.
- B. The Town Board shall erect stop signs as provided in this ordinance on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

This ordinance is effective ^{April 23rd AB} ~~May 15~~, 2026.


The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis. Stats.
