TOWN OF BONE LAKE ORDINANCE 2017-01

ORDINANCE REGULATING HOUSE NUMBER REPLACEMENT POLICY

PURPOSE: The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a policy for replacing house number signs in the Town. Following a recent survey of all house number signs, it was found that there was a need for many house number signs to be replaced. Adequate signage serves to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Town by providing an efficient means for locating properties in the event of a necessary sheriff, fire, EMS, or other emergency response.

AUTHORITY: The Town Board of the Town of Bone Lake has the specific authority granted by Wis. Statutes 60.10(2) (c) and 60.22(3).

SCOPE: The Town Board of the Town of Bone Lake does ordain as follows:

- 1. The Town will install the first house number sign that is issued by the Polk County Zoning Administration.
- 2. Missing or faded house number signs are the responsibility of the landowner/resident. The issue will be addressed with a letter sent by the Town to the landowner/resident. A \$10 fee (includes installation), with 30 days to pay to the Town Treasurer.
- 3. If the \$10 fee is not paid within the 30 day notice period, the Town will order a new sign and install it. The landowner/resident shall then be billed for the total cost of \$100, payable to the Town Treasurer. This includes a new sign, post (if needed), locating the site and installation.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective upon publication and posting on the Town website.
